RISK STATEMENT

Watercraft Racing is by its nature a dangerous sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk.

By participating in or becoming involved with watercraft racing organised by Powerboat P1 either as a participant, team member or otherwise individuals agree and acknowledge that:

- (i) they are aware of the inherent risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for exposing themselves to such inherent risk, including risks to their person, their property, drowning, hypothermia, collision injuries burns and other physical injuries as well as possible death
- (ii) they have satisfied themselves that they have the necessary skill and knowledge to take part in the event and deal with the conditions that may arise in the course of a race
- (iii) they will not participate in the event whilst under the undue influence of alcohol, drugs or whilst otherwise unfit to participate
- (iv) they are responsible for the safety of themselves their team their personal watercraft and their property whether afloat or ashore
- (v) the management of their personal water including insurance is solely their responsibility
- (vi) technical scrutineering does not constitute a condition survey of the personal watercraft and it is solely their responsibility to decide whether or not to start or to continue in any AquaX race
- (vii) ensuring the efficiency and suitability of the helmets and wetsuit vests worn is solely their responsibility
- (viii) the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other volunteers by the event organisers does not relieve them of their responsibilities
- (ix) the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance particularly in extreme weather conditions as can be practically provided in the circumstances
- to be bound by the conditions of the Race Entry Form, Racing Instructions and the General Competition Rules of AquaX and the IJSBA
- (xi) they will accept the decisions of the organising committee and officials nominated by the organising committee.

INDEMNITY

Participants in the event will be required on signing on to the event to save harmless and keep indemnified:

- (a) The owners of the premises at which the event is held;
- (b) The organising club, the sponsors and the IJSBA and their respective officials, servants and agents; and,
- (c) The other personal watercraft owners, drivers, passengers or mechanics engaged in the meeting (together with the "Indemnified Parties") AGAINST all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the property of or personal injury sustained to the Indemnified Parties to the extent caused by the participants, their crew, their boat, their mechanics, support team, representatives or agents.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Persons under the age of 18 must have written authority signed by either Parent or Guardian, Proof of age is required.

1. EVENT SANCTION

This event has been approved by the International Jetsport Boating Association (IJSBA) and the Federation Française Motonautique. The IJSBA will serve as the sanctioning body for the event and his international promoter Powerboat P1 provides the event insurance package. All competitors must be current IJSBA members.

2. P1 MEMBERSHIP

Riders taking part in a P1 event must hold a P1 membership card. The cost of membership is automatically included in the fee when registering for a rider's first event of the season and is valid until the first event of 2020.

7. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The race/s will be run under current rules as stated in AquaX 2019 rulebook together with these Race Instructions and any other instructions issued before or at Riders' Briefings or in Race Bulletins. The Organizers reserve the right to change these Instructions at any time for safety reasons, provided that any change will be in accordance with the current rules. Any changes will be notified to competitors in a Race Bulletin and, if possible, announced at Riders' Briefing. Any infringement of the Rules or of the Race Instructions, or instructions issued at Riders' Briefings or in race Bulletins may lead to disqualification or other penalties being applied by the organizing club.

Organizers have the right to refuse any watercraft which they consider unsuitable and/or which does not conform to the requirements of the present rules. The Organizers may cancel or postpone the event or a race at any time in the event of bad weather, equipment failure or otherwise. The entry fee is not refundable.

8. RACE ADMINISTRATION AND REGISTRATION

On arrival at the race site, all competitors must report to the Race Administration and sign the wavier located at:

IMPORTANT: INSURANCE INFORMATION

All competitors must produce a valid IJSBA membership. Riders not in possession of the correct paperwork will not be allowed to race. **IMPORTANT INSURANCE INFORMATION** All riders must present a valid insurance policy for personal accident and repatriation. Insurance can be purchased on site for €80 for the week-end or €120 yearly if the competitor has a **IJSBA valid membership issued by his country of residency**.

All competitors must produce a valid race licence/membership from their country of residence.

- 1. Age regulations apply at the date of the race.
- 2. Rider under the age of 18 must provide evidence of their age
- 3. Riders under 18 years of age must be accompanied at the event by a Parent/Guardian. All who are under 18 on the date of the race will be required to submit written consent of their parent or guardian to their participation in the race and confirmation of their acceptance of the rules governing the race.

9. AQUAX RACER TRAINING

Classroom training will take place in the **GRAND HOTEL DES SABLETTES** – see timetable for time and location. All riders taking part in AquaX for the first time regardless of experience must take part in AquaX Racer Training. For the Saturday morning on water training, make sure you have your race equipment and safety gear with you as you will be launching and riding to complete the practical element of the training program. For those arriving early and not taking part in training, please be aware that new racers must take priority so they can join their class

PLEASE NOTE: completing the AquaX Racer Training course does not necessarily mean a racer will be allowed to race. The racer must demonstrate, to the instructor, a level of competence to gain a pass before being allowed to race.

10. PIT AREAS, PARKING & SPECIAL CONDITIONS

DRY PIT

Dry Pit is located on Port de Lazaret - 83500 La Seyne-sur-Mer and open on Friday at 9am, Dry pit is <u>exclusively reserved</u> for riders' vehicles. Accompanying persons <u>must</u> use car parks next to the official dry pit. A Pit Marshal will be responsible for your placement. At no point should you assemble your pit area/tent without the agreement of the Pit Marshal..

An electricity supply (motorhome electric plug P17 type) and fresh water point will be made available from Friday morning in the dry pit. Toilets and showers can be located on the beach.

Please note: Barbecues are strictly forbidden within the dry pit area.


All generators must be turned off after 23.00 on the night. A penalty will be issued if you breach this rule.


No reservation in the dry pit is permitted by riders for other riders. First come, first served.

Dry Pit access - OPEN FRIDAY, MAY 3rd at 9am :


For information: the dry pit will be monitored from Friday May 4 at 8am to Sunday 6pm - 24 / 24h by a security guard.

WET PIT

The WET PIT is located in the Port of St Elme. Access to the port is a road. Please note: You can use ATV or your car to take your watercraft to the entrance of the wet pit/harbour area.

Wet pit/Port St Elme is approximately 750m. See map below for directions. It is a legal requirement that you wear a helmet when driving an ATV.

WARNING: it is forbidden to ride PWC in the bay of Toulon - you can not under any circumstances launch your machine in the bay of Lazaret (in front of the dry pit).

11. PRE RACE SAFETY TECH

Pre-race safety tech will take place in accordance with Class specific rules in 2019 AquaX Rulebook. Pre-race tech will take place in the Dry Pit area in the Port of Lazaret. You must sign in before your watercraft can go through tech. Post-race tech will take place in the designated area in the on Dry Pit.

Please note:

- Pre race technical inspection does not constitute a condition survey of the watercraft.
- Pre race technical inspection does not constitute the watercraft as legal for class participation in an AquaX event.
- The Technical inspection sheet may not necessarily cover every item that Technical Director may wish to check on a particular watercraft nor does every item necessarily refer to every class of watercraft.
- The AquaX Technical Director shall reject a craft if it does not comply with all of the requirements of the Organizer.

The AquaX Technical Director shall refer any noncompliance to the Race Director. Any decision related to eligibility shall be made in good time before the start of the race

FUELLING

Refuelling is ONLY permitted in the designated re-fuelling area within the pit areas. If refuelling on the beach spill pads must be used.

- a. All race craft must arrive fully fuelled.
- b. All fuel must be carried in fuel jugs with properly fitting spouts made for the purpose and marked 'Highly Flammable'. Open funnels are not allowed.
- c. Competitors are reminded to check current or relevant directives regarding the transportation of fuel.
- d. Fuel may not be transferred between tanks during a race.
- e. Fuel transfer outside any designated fuelling areas will result in a fine.
- f. Any entrant disposing of fuels or lubricants in the pit area or on the racecourse by pouring or spilling such fuels or lubricants is subject to a fine and will be disqualified from the event.
- g. When refuelling in the wet pits, a fuelling mat must be placed under the ski, spill kits and fire extinguisher must also be within close reach.

12. RIDERS BRIEFING

All AquaX Riders' (Pro and Am) briefing will take place at **Grand Hotel des Sablettes Plage - Hilton Saturday 9.00am**, 500m far from the dry pit. All Riders must attend the appropriate briefing. A Roll Call may be held. Penalty for absence may be disqualification from starting the race or other penalties as defined in Class Rules or by the race organisers. Breathalyser and Drug tests may be given.



13. LAUNCHING

Launching is the Riders responsibility and should not be undertaken before safety tech, unless otherwise stated. Competitors are reminded to comply with all local regulations concerning the use of the beaches and the water. Details of the marshalling area and procedures will be given at Riders' Briefing. Absolutely no launching unless the Race Director grants permission. More information regarding launching will be provided at the riders meeting.

14. OFFICIAL PRACTICE ARRANGEMENTS

Official Enduro practice will take place before RACE 1 unless stated otherwise. Competitors will be required to complete one parade lap, one start run followed by a minimum of 2 further practice laps including the penalty buoy. Full details will be explained at Riders' briefing.

15. ROLLING STARTS, STANDING STARTS

Full details of the starting procedure will be given at Riders' Briefing however all class specific starts are explained in the 2019 AQX rulebook.

ENDURO RACE COURSE - The schematic drawing of the course in these Race Instructions is provided for competitors assistance and should not to be used as a chart for navigational purposes. Lap/Finish Line AQX: The finish line is marked by chequered buoy opposite the timekeepers' position ashore.

STARTS - ROLLING STARTS, STANDING STARTS, BEACH STARTS, CLASS SPECIFIC STARTS

Full details of the starting procedure will be given at Riders' Briefing however all class specific starts are explained in the 2019 AquaX Rulebook. A rolling start will be used for both classes. The Enduro class may be staggered between classes depending on final entry numbers. Full description will be explained at Riders' briefing.

Course Marks:

A full description of the shape and colour of each course mark will be given at Riders' briefing, including the start run and any Exclusion Zones or hazards.

AQUAX ENDURO COURSE DETAILS

The final course design dependant on weather conditions and entry - subject to change. Enduro Start Run AQX: 1m / 1.6km - Enduro Course length: 2.2m/ 4km

COURSE SCHEMATIC - COLOUR OF BUOYS MAY CHANGE - RIDERS WILL BE BRIEFED AT RIDERS MEETING.



16. FLAG SIGNALS

All flag signals are fully described in 2019 AquaX Rulebook General Racing Rules and Class specific rules where differences occur. All Competitors must have a full understanding of all flag signals.

17. POST-RACE TECHNICAL

Post Tech tents area will be announce during riders briefing. Competitors must be available with their craft and all relevant mandatory equipment required by class rules for post-race Tech if required, up to one hour after the posting of the results. One or more engines may be checked and fuel sampling may take place.

18. PENALTIES

In addition to the penalties referred to in class rules, the following penalties will apply at this event: Penalties will be applied as per class rules – see rule AX 45.

19. PROTESTS

Protests should be submitted in accordance with 2019 AquaX Rulebook – AX 46.

A Mandatory arbitration session with the Race Director or Appointed person is to be held before any formal protests or appeals will be accepted. If unresolved the rider will be given a P1 AquaX protest or appeal form. Formal protests or appeals must be made in writing by the rider/s involved and will be logged with the Series Administrator. Protests from third parties will not be accepted.

20. PRIZE GIVING

Trophies will be presented to the top 3 in each class. Podium presentations will take place adjacent to the Race Centre after the final race on Sunday.

IMPORTANT - PODIUM FINISHERS MUST BE PRESENT AND WEAR RACE VESTS ON PODIUM.

Trophies will be presented to the top 3 in each class.

All podium finishers must wear their race vests on the podium. Failure to do so will result in penalties as per rule AX45. Riders are asked to refrain from inviting family members to join them on the podium until after the official presentation, photography and filming has taken place. Riders may then ask for further time for family photos.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Safety takes priority over racing at all times

All race boats MUST observe the International Rules for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea (IRPCS) when encountering any other non-racing craft.

- a. Swimmers, board sailors, private and commercial craft of all types may be encountered. Competitors are reminded to keep a sharp look-out at all times and to take the necessary action in accordance with the IRPCS rules.
- b. Competitors are reminded to keep a sharp look-out at all times for any marine wildlife that may be encountered in the vicinity of the race course and take the necessary avoiding action.
- c. Competitors are warned to remember their speed and the fact that other craft may not be fully aware or able to keep clear.
- d. Competitors are asked to bear in mind that official patrol and rescue boats have no power to insist that any craft or swimmer should keep clear of the course of the race. Advice can only be given for the safety of other craft and swimmers.
- e. International Code Flag 'A' denotes DIVERS. Competitors must give a wide clearance of at least 100 yards.
- f. The course will be patrolled by official patrol and rescue boats with official observer boats in the vicinity of certain race marks; other race marks may be observed from the shore.
- g. Any official patrol or rescue boat may wave a yellow flag to give warning of imminent danger in its vicinity.
- h. Competitors seeing this signal are to acknowledge the signal, proceed with caution, not overtake other race boats whilst in the area of the incident and keep clear of the danger area. Any competitor who ignores or abuses the yellow flag may be penalised
